Service?"


For some, the memories of past experiences and the pain of present situations can become overwhelming. The Christmas season can be very difficult and a reminder of the challenges of our lives.

Missions and Outreach

Altar Rail Offerings for the month of December will go to the United Methodist Global AIDS Fund.

The United Methodist Global AIDS Fund (UMGAF) was established in 2004 by the General Conference. This was in response to the global AIDS pandemic and the purpose is to "stem the tide" of HIV and AIDS around the world and strengthen The United

Methodist Church's compassionate response to this deadly pandemic. The UMGAF supports programs that focus on education, prevention, care, advocacy, testing, treatment, and counseling for people living with HIV and AIDS.

Since 1981 (the onset of the AIDS pandemic), 79 million people have become infected with the HIV virus and about 39 million have died from HIV. Globally, about 37 million people are living with HIV. Approximately, 7,500 people are infected daily, including about 900 babies born with HIV.
