Missions and Outreach

Alter Rail Offerings for the month of December will go to the United Methodist Global AIDS Fund.



The United Methodist Global AIDS Fund (UMGAF) was established in 2004 by the General Conference. This was in response to the global AIDS pandemic and the purpose was/is to "stem the tide" of HIV and AIDS around the world, and strengthen The United Methodist Church's compassionate response to this deadly pandemic. The UMGAF supports programs that focus on education, prevention, care, advocacy, testing, treatment and counseling for people living with HIV and AIDS.

Since 1981, (the onset of the AIDS pandemic): 79 million people have become infected with the HIV virus and about 39 million have died from HIV. Globally, about 37 million people are living with HIV or AIDS. Approximately 7,500 people are infected daily, including about 900 babies born with HIV.

With your generous donations the face of AIDS is changing in the world. More persons now have access to life-saving drugs and treatment programs, which is reducing the number of overall deaths. As Methodists, let's work together, to continue to change the face of this deadly disease.
