Reflecting back on 2022, the men of the Church along with the help of several great women, accomplished many things. These included helping to maintain our physical plant and ongoing maintenance such as grass cutting, trimming of trees and bushes, weed eating, blowing off the parking lot, herbicide and fire ant treatment, and every ones favorite "spreading mulch." Both of our breakfast fund raisers last year were a great success with over \$1,000.00 in net profit which will go to support our mission work. The recipients for 2022 are Murphy Harpst Children's Center (Cedartown, GA), Fayette Samaritans, Toys for Tots (Coweta/Fayette), and Square Foot Ministry.

Thanks for all of the Church members, family and friends who supported us during past year. Our next meeting will be on Wednesday, January 11, 2023 at 9:00 AM in the Fellowship Hall. Breakfast will be provided.



During 2022, we were able to complete many projects around the Church. The air conditioning unit and some duct work were replaced at the Griffith Youth House. The parking lot was relined and the handicapped spaces and speed bumps were painted. Major bush pruning and tree trimming were done at the parsonage and around the Fellowship Hall. Also, a serious effort was made to clean the aging carpeting in the education wing. In the attic of the education wing, the walkways were reworked to facilitate easier access to the three HVAC units.

For 2023, the big projects include more gutter repairs and installing additional leaf guards, painting and reglazing the sanctuary and office windows, repairing and reupholstering the acolyte chairs, replacing the water line from Hills Bridge Road to the youth house, and repairing the drainage ditch on the south side of the parking lot.
