The Psalmist writes in Psalm 95:1-2 (NRSV), O come, let us sing to the LORD; let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation! Let us come into his presence with thanksgiving; let us make a joyful noise to him with songs of praise!"

Time and time again, we see a call towards Thanksgiving, a call towards lifting songs of praise before our God. Yet it can be hard at times to be thankful. Fayette Samaritans is a Christian ministry serving families in Fayette County that are in critical need of food, clothing and emergency financial assistance.


This ministry is run by volunteers that selflessly give their time to serve the needs of others.
