A note from the Pastor

As we prepare for Laity Sunday this month, we're invited to reflect on the many legacies that shape who we are as a church. These legacies that not only the buildings we gather in or the programs we run, but the stories of faith lived out in quiet, faithful ways over time.

connections.


They provide guidance in living options and enhance community living through their "Welcome Home Ministry."
